Dear Stage 3 Parents/Carers,

Thanks to the easing of COVID restrictions lately we have been informed that we are now able to visit Possum Early Childhood Centre to read and play with the students!

Therefore we can again focus on strengthening our connections to the wider community, in order to get word circulating in the community about all the outstanding learning and activities going on every day at our awesome school *Our Lady of the Nativity*. So beginning in Term 2 and hopefully for the rest of the year, we would like to offer an opportunity to all our Stage 3 students to both develop and extend their Literacy and Leadership skills, while strengthening connections with the wider community. We have arranged with one of our local Pre-Schools at this point of time: *Possum Early Childhood Centre (Hazelbrook)*, for our Stage 3 students to go, play and read with small groups of their students on a Monday or Friday. Our Stage 3 students would travel to and from the centres with a teacher (mainly Mrs Samojlowicz) in their car at 10am; read/play with a small group of children, talk to them about the book and then return to school at approximately 10:45am. This is an optional extracurricular activity, but one we are strongly encouraging this year in order to really focus on developing both Literacy and Leadership skills. Students who take up this amazing opportunity will be put on a roster so that each student will know when it is their turn so they can prepare a picture book to read. This is a great service to our community which will also be added to their school student record.

Again this is not a compulsory activity, but would be a fabulous way to serve our community and of course develop reading skills - fluency, expression, attention to punctuation, comprehension, confidence; and not to mention their leadership skills - representing our community, conversing with adults and children, preparing and leading a small group of children.

If your child would like to participate and you would be happy for them to travel to and from the centre in a teacher's car, please complete the attached permission sheet and return to school ASAP, as we will be starting next term. The teachers will develop a roster so that your child will know in advance when they will participate. If you have any questions please feel free to talk with Mr Hortense or myself.
